In this intermediate level workshop, Marshall B. Rosenberg, PhD, international peacemaker, author, and educator will use exercises, role playing, stories and songs to demonstrate the principles of Nonviolent Communication (NVC) and to show how the process can enhance our relationships and contribute to world peace.
